

WNC Election Set for December 2, 2004

An election to fill all elected seats on the Westside Neighborhood Council will take place December 2. All Tract No. 7260 stakeholders are eligible to vote for Office No. 10.

(A stakeholder is anyone connected to 7260 as a resident, worker, student or participant in the work of a non-profit within 7260.) Seven council seats represent residents in various sub districts; six represent large and small businesses. One seat is at-large and represents the entire district. Three non-elective seats represent schools, religious institutions, and non-profits. Council members are elected for two years and serve without pay.

Voting will take place at the West-side Pavilion Community Rooms A and B, adjacent to the Food Court. The polling place will be open from 4 to 8 p.m. The election will be super-vised by the League of Women Voters.

Dick Harnetz has announced his intention to run for 7260's seat, Office No. 10. At this writing, he is the only candidate for the office.
