

Westwood Charter Launches Fund Drive To Pay for Revitalized School Schoolyard

Stephanie Schulman, principal of Westwood Charter School, has announced a plan to revitalize her school's yard.

Some Proposition BB money has been allotted to cover the resurfacing. However, money is being sought for areas with basketball, volleyball, a grass field, a track, three shaded seating areas, new lunch tables, a garden/outdoor classroom with drought-resistant native plants, colorful mosaics on the planters and benches in the northwest corner, new trees throughout the yard, new greenery around the bungalows, a butterfly and hummingbird garden, five new *fitness court* pieces, and colorful, creative striping of game areas throughout the yard. Plans also call for an upgrade to the Kindergarten yard which will be resurfaced, and will feature fence webbing and a multi-use sandbox.
