

## Traffic Mitigations Proposed for Tract 7260

Of the over \$3 million currently available for traffic mitigation made necessary by Century City construction, Councilmember Weiss has allocated \$300,000 to the area directly west of Century City. Weiss has allocated approximately \$3 million to alleviate traffic in Cheviot Hills.

At its June meeting, 7260 discussed the possibility of implementing a number of traffic mitigations within and near the track. No conclusions were reached at the meeting. Input from 7260 residents will be sought before the Association asks for any mitigations from the City. Here is a list of the mitigations proposed so far:

Here is a list of the mitigations proposed so far:

- No turn on red signal at southbound Century Park West (right turn on green arrow only) turning onto westbound Olympic
- Four way stop signs at Benecia and La Grange
- Olympic and Beverly Glen stop light photo enforcement (4-Way Intersection)
- Left arrow at eastbound Pico onto northbound Beverly Glen
- No left turn sign on south bound traffic at Beverly Glen at Mississippi (7 to 9a.m only), and at Missouri.(7 to 9 a.m.) (This is a proposed TEMPORARY mitigation directly relating to cut-through traffic from the Santa Monica Boulevard Project until completion of the project.)
- Northbound stop sign on Benecia at Missouri. Left turn with arrow from eastbound Olympic onto northbound Century Park East
- Left turn with arrow from eastbound Olympic onto northbound Century Park East.
- Speed bumps on Benecia (La Grange to Missouri)
- No left turn from 7 a.m. to 10 a. m. at La Grange from southbound Beverly Glen
- No left turn on Benecia from Little S. M. during any time hours of construction at the corner of S. M. and Beverly Glen (already implemented)
